Nitrogen form and availability has a big influence on where the plant puts its growth. Get it wrong and crops allocate too much resource to foliar growth and not enough to root and tuber development, get it right and yield and quality follows.

Expert crop scientist; David Marks will provide answers to questions such as:

- How can I maintain N levels without excess top growth?
- How can I encourage flow of carbohydrates from canopy to tubers?
- How do I reduce size variation in root crops?
- How can I improve bulking?
- How can I get tuber numbers and size up?

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
